- Geotechnical Soil Borings complete by February 16th
- Survey complete by February 16th
- Permitting submit to USACE / City for permits based upon preliminary design starting February 16th and running through April 8th
- Sheet pile sizing calculations / design complete March 31st
- Bidding for sheet pile / walers / etc. April 9th April 30th
- Site design complete April 15th
- Bidding for construction April 15th May 7th
- Project Award May 8th

Our work will be performed on a Lump Sum basis with the exception to the surveying provided at a time and material basis. Please see below for an explanation of our anticipated fees and expenses.

*Should the Owner elect, these services may be provided in phases. These phases would be anticipated to breakdown as indicated below.

Phase I: Conceptual Design / Permitting - \$82,000.00

Phase II: Final Design - \$44,500.00
